• Set up a personal email account• Send, receive and reply to emails• Send emails with attachments • Create a new folder to store files• Downloading from emails• Search online for specific information• Recognise secure and reliable websites• Recognise common online scams• Recognise spam or phishing emails• Understand basic online safety and privacy• Create strong passwords and keep them safe• Create and edit simple documents on Microsoft Word• Format text (bold, bullet points, font size)

- Use a computer and the internet with greater independence
- Stay safe and make informed choices when using digital technology
- Feel more confident using technology in everyday life
- Progress onto an Entry 3 Essential Digital Skills Qualification

Face to face.

Anyone finishing the Digital Skills for Beginners course and other adults with some IT skills who are lacking in confidence.

Entry requirements:

No previous IT qualifications.

Progression route:

Completion of this course should allow progression onto the Essential Digital Skills qualification.

DISCLAIMER:

You must be 19+ on 31 August 2026 and ordinarily resident in England for the last 3 years. You must also be resident in the Greater Lincolnshire County Council Area (GLCCA) on the first day of learning.

When applying for this course, you must provide evidence to confirm eligibility for funding, this includes proof of ID and proof of address. In addition, we will also require evidence if your income and or benefits, if £26,800 gross or below.
